Lisa M. Siefker-Bailey is a Lecturer at Indiana University-Purdue University Columbus, where she teaches a wide variety of writing and literature classes. She received a B.A. in English from Albion College in Albion, Michigan, her first Master's in English at Oakland University in Rochester, Michigan, and a Ph.D. in English from Vanderbilt University. Dr. Siefker-Bailey is currently the faculty sponsor for the English Club and the IUPUC student literary magazine: Talking Leaves. She serves as Treasurer of the Conference on Christianity and Literature, an international society allied with the Modern Language Association. She has been awarded by The Faculty Colloquium on Excellence in Teaching on numerous occasions. Dr. Siefker-Bailey has served as a judge for poetry contests, speech contests, play performances, and leadership awards. She has given multiple talks to local K-

12 schools, has offered classes through Partners in Education and has served as a dramatic and theatre expert at Theatre on the Square in Indianapolis as well as a wide variety of regional theatre productions. Her main areas of interest are twentieth-century American literature, drama, and the scholarship of teaching and learning. She has contributed a chapter, "Absurdly American: Rediscovering the Representation of Violence in The Zoo Story" to Routledge's Edward Albee: A Casebook, and her article, "Fraught with Fire: Race and Theology in Gilead," is forthcoming in the Winter 2010 issue of Christianity and Literature.

Dr. Siefker-Bailey will speak about ways of reading Marilynne Robinson's Pulitzer-prize winning novel, Gilead, and its companion novel, Home, which won the Orange Prize from Britain. Come and learn about ways to improve your quality of life by experiencing the literary arts firsthand. You'll be glad you did! A question/answer period will follow her discussion.
