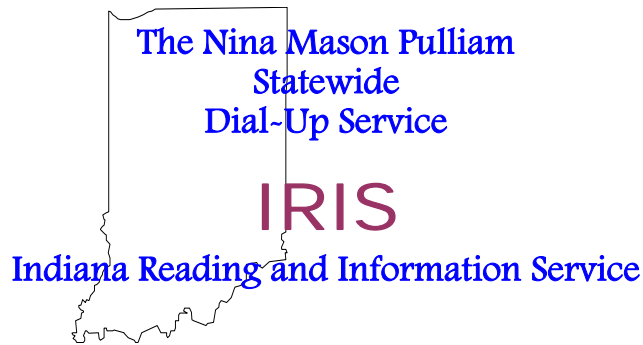

### *What is IRIS?*

- ❖ IRIS is a not-for-profit communications link to the visually and print impaired. (*Legally blind, Visually impaired, Physically impaired, Reading disabled, Illiterate*)
- ❖ IRIS is a service which allows the visual and print impaired to dial a **toll-free** number and listen to the newspaper, recorded daily by volunteers.
- ❖ IRIS recordings are accessible to listeners 24 hours a day/7 days a week via any **touch-tone** phone.
- ❖ IRIS is made possible by a grant from the Nina Mason Pulliam Charitable Trust and is operated out of the WFYI TelePlex, Indianapolis.

### *What do IRIS Volunteers do?*

- ❖ IRIS volunteers record the ***Herald Times*** newspaper, via a toll-free number, from their home using a headset telephone provided by the IRIS Program.
- ❖ IRIS volunteers choose the section of the ***Herald Times*** they wish to record and the day of the week they wish to record at time of application (recording takes 30 to 40 minutes to complete).
- ✓ Front Page – read all of front page starting with Today’s Weather and read all of the Front Page starting at the top of the page.
- ✓ City/Local – read Police Beat, Letters to the Editor, Local interest articles, Out & About, Thank you NOTES, Datebook, Weddings and Anniversaries and Local School Articles.
- ✓ Sports – Local sports, scores and articles.
- ✓ Obituaries – List names of deceased, then read each obituary.

### *How can I become an IRIS volunteer?*
